**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 3rd day of December, 2020, pursuant to the Supreme Court Orders of April 28, 2020 and May 27, 2020, which allowed the President Judge of any judicial district the discretion to extend the period of judicial emergency beyond June 1, 2020, it is hereby ordered that the judicial emergency declared for the seventh judicial district is extended for the following, limited purpose:

1. No jury trials, whether criminal or civil in nature and without regard to the number of jurors required, will be conducted prior to March 1, 2021.

This order supersedes any previously entered emergency order regarding suspension of jury trials.
